Class Hours: This course will have 72 class hours, including 40 lecture hours, 10 lecturer office hours, 10-hour TA discussion sessions, 2-hour review sessions, 10-hour extra classes.

Course Description:

This course is designed for students with little or no background in Japanese. We cover “Genki I” Lessons 1 through 5. It is designed to develop students’ four language skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing. Moreover, this course will prepare students to demonstrate their proficiencies across the three communication modes: interpretive, interpersonal, and presentational.

Course Objectives:

Students will be able to introduce themselves and others, ask questions, issue invitations, talk



about past, present and future activities, and more. Students will also be able to read and write hiragana, katakana, and 43 kanji characters. By the end of the course, students are expected to reach a novice-mid, or higher, level of proficiency as defined by the ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) Proficiency Guidelines.
